This Course

The Certificates I and II in English Proficiency are designed for international students for whom English is a second language and who wish to improve their access to and functionality within Australian society and the community in general, and to the employment and training market in particular.

Students who successfully complete the **Certificate I** will be able to use the English language to satisfy basic survival needs in the community and workplace in a limited range of familiar and routine contexts.

Students who successfully complete the **Certificate II** will be able to use the English language to satisfy essential social and workplace needs in a range of familiar and predictable contexts. They will be able to participate in other preparatory courses, including broad-based general education and entry level workplace training.

Students who successfully complete the **Certificates III and IV** will have acquired English language skills that enable them to have access to further study and career opportunities.

At Hosanna International College; Certificate IV is integrated into the Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/Division 2 Nursing) as an elective; to enable students to complete their certificate in English Proficiency and the Diploma course simultaneously.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for the certificates. Prior to enrolment, on the basis of a pre-enrolment interview, students are placed into the appropriate level of qualification depending on their English language proficiency.

Each certificate is structured to allow maximum flexibility for students dependent on their learning needs and skill levels. Each stage of each certificate builds on the skills and knowledge developed in the preceding stage/certificate.

Generally, **Certificate I** and **II** are catering for students who are below IELTS Level 5. **Certificate III** is catering for students who have attained IELTS Level 5 or 5.5.
